



Foothills Unitarian Universalist Fellowship is a liberal faith community in Maryville, TN, located between Knoxville and The Great Smoky Mountains National Park. We chartered two years ago and are currently 69 members strong. We are members of the Thomas Jefferson District and the UUA.

Foothills UU Fellowship's mission is to create a religious community that encourages spiritual growth, celebrates personal and religious diversity and challenges us to live our values conscientiously through service and example within our congregation and in the larger community.

Foothills UU Fellowship holds worship services on the first and third Sunday of each month at a rented space when we also offer Faith Development classes for both children and adults. We are members of the Blount County Ecumenical Action Council, through which we actively support three local, non-profit service organizations. We recently hired a part time Fellowship Administrator, who publishes our bimonthly newsletter through our listserv and on our website.

Our immediate goals are to offer worship services every Sunday and to acquire a dedicated space to expand our programming and community outreach by 2012.

Foothills UU Fellowship is seeking a consulting minister to begin January 2011. We would like one Sunday service per month, a limited amount of pastoral care, and assistance with helping our fellowship realize its vision. We have budgeted \$500 a month for a period of 6 months. At the end of this period, the Fellowship will reassess its needs and consider extending the consulting minister for an additional 6 months.
