Dr. Helen Bishop is a consultant for faith-based organizations, particularly in the areas of conflict management, right relations and diversity. She served as District Executive for the Unitarian Universalist Association for eight years, is a credentialed religious educator, master level, and has a doctorate in organizational leadership. Dr. Bishop currently resides in Hendersonville, NC with her partner of many years, Susan Grider.

B - Governance and Leadership Development, led by Annette Marquis

Annette Marquis is Thomas Jefferson District Executive, and was recently appointed Regional Lead District Staff Person of the Southland Region (consisting of Florida, Mid-South, Southwest Conference and TJ Districts).

C - Faith Development, led by Sue Sinnamon

Rev. Sue Sinnamon is the TJD Director of Faith Development.

D - What Works? Best Practices in Congregations, led by Jake Morrill

Rev. Jake B. Morrill is minister of Oak Ridge UU Church, Oak Ridge, TN, and currently serves as TJD Trustee on the UUA Board.
